August 1, 2018

Starting **Monday, August 6th**, the 20 E. St. Charles Road parking lot (for resident-only quarterly permit commuters and shoppers) will be closed until further notice.

The Village has contracted with Omega III LLC of Elgin to demolish the Central Reservoir Facility and the Pressure Adjusting Station, adjacent to the parking lot. After demolition, another contract will be awarded to construct a new pressure adjusting station and parking lot. The parking lot is expected to reopen in the late spring/early summer of 2019.



As of August 6th, please utilize the parking lot at 101 South Main, located south of the tracks on the east side of Main Street. A map is provided on the reverse side of this flyer. Commuters that normally park at 20 East St. Charles Road will be allowed to park at 101 South Main starting on August 6th. Please display your parking permit. Parking will be limited to the permit spaces only. Do not park in the designated daily fee spaces (stalls 660 – 699).
